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Saturday: Day One - Arrival

Arrive at Cozumel International Airport (code CZM). Get bags and navigate through customs. Your Spartan Dive Team rep will meet you out front and get you shuttled to our resort, where your other Spartan rep will help you get checked in, show you around, and get you registered at the dive shop.

Certified divers, you're on your own for the afternoon: head into town for grocery items or just grab a tank and jump into your bubble therapy!

Spartans to be, this is where your adventure begins! We will quickly get into our superhero SCUBA gear and start our first certification skills and dive. The goal will be to get at least one dive, but two is even better!



Dinner. We will be planning a group, get-acquainted dinner at the resort tonight. Be prepared to share stories about why, when, and how long SCUBA has been on your mind and in your life. Let's share our passions for life and living!

Sunday: Day Two - SCUBA Life



Breakfast starts daily at 0700. Join the line for the breakfast buffet and get your noms in while you can. Boats start arriving around 0800 for certified divers to shuffle aboard and get situated.

Spartans to be, you will have the entire morning to yourself! Lay in the sun, head into town, or relax on a pool lounger while reading a book (aka "napping"). The morning boat dives are usually back around noon for lunch, after which we'll head back out and wrap up the remaining required 2-3 dives.

Evening plans are up to you. Glom onto one another or your Spartan Dive Team leaders or go it alone: the adventure is yours to choose!

Monday: Day Three - Everybody on the Boat

From today until Thursday night, we'll all be together!

Morning boat 2-tank dive will probably be a bit shallower, no deeper than 60 fsw, to accommodate our first-time bubble heads. But, since that's where the best stuff to see lives, all the better!

Back for lunch and then free time until the evening when anyone who wants to experience shore diving at night is welcome to join our Chief Spartan on an epic diving adventure. Don't be surprised to see a spotted eagle ray zoom right past you, baby drum fish, lionfish, and lots of other little critters skuttling about the sea floor.

Tuesday: Day Four - Yes please!

Morning boat dive for everybody! The afternoon will consist of a specially scheduled 1-tank boat dive to explore the inside of a wreck. Advanced divers only on this one. Other boat dives can be scheduled or joined.

Dinner: on Tuesdays we like to go to a great little place just north of the resort for dinner and a nightcap at the Blue Angel. Hopefully they'll have lionfish back on the menu! This isn't a requirement, just something we like to do as a group. It's nice to get out and enjoy the local fare once in a while, but you can't beat the all-inclusive meals at the resort either.

Wednesday: Day Five - Best Groundhog Day EVER

Let's do yesterday again, only this time, after a free afternoon we have the option to schedule a 2-tank "twilight" dive. This gets us in the water at dusk, and then back down again for a night dive. Talk about a whole new perspective on the underwater life in the area: octopus and decorator crabs are just some of the creatures to spot out and about!

Thursday: Day Six - Yes please!

Morning boat dives; hopefully this time we'll be diving some of the deeper walls.

Once we return, the afternoon is wide open. Schedule more boat dives, blow bubbles off the shore, or head into town for some time on two legs.

Friday: Day Seven - Divergence

For most of us, this is an off day. Remember that the rule is 24

hours between your flight and surfacing from your last dive. Your Spartan Dive Team will be heading out for a 2-tank morning technical dive which should put us back just before the end of lunch, and well within our pre-flight requirements, while our brand-new Spartans will be headed out for their fifth 2-tank boat dive of the week.

Divers should feel free to schedule boat dives or jump into the water with a tank out front of the resort as desired, just watch your times!



Dinner. Tonight, we'll be headed into town for an amazing group goodbye meal at a beautiful Italian restaurant with a spectacular open courtyard and memory-making food.

Saturday: Day Seven - The Long Goodbye

Get up, have coffee, and breakfast before heading back to your room to pack everything up. Get ready to check out by noon. Make sure you check out at the dive shop to disperse your tips for the dive boat and resort divemaster appropriately.

Depending on time, we will have lunch on site, take some final photos, exchange contact information, and then convoy to the airport en masse.







THINGS TO KNOW

Financial: \$300 non-refundable deposit due at booking. 50% balance due 45 days before trip start date; remainder balance

due by 30 days before trip start date.

Insurance: Travel Insurance is highly recommended: consider DAN Trip Insurance Elite Plan. Cost is less than \$200 and includes

75% reimbursement for "any reason" cancellation.

DAN (Diver's Alert Network) diver insurance is highly recommended. Minimal annual cost for individual or family

plan; covers recompression chamber and search and rescue, which may not be covered by personal insurance.

There are four recompression chambers on the island of Cozumel.

inclusive meals and beverages; taxes and fees (except Marine Park Fee*).

Spartan to Be rate is based on SDI Open Water supplies and training; 7 nights at Casa del Mar; 5 days of 2-tank boat

dives; unlimited shore dives; all inclusive meals and beverages; taxes and fees (except Marine Park Fee*).

Non-diver rate has limited availability and includes 7 nights at Casa del Mar; all inclusive meals and beverages;

taxes and fees.

Included: Weights and weight belts at Cozumel Marine World dive shop; time and attention of your friendly Spartans.

Available: Any matter of SCUBA equipment for rental; Nitrox fills at 32%

Not included: Dive tips; Marine Park Fee*; trip/travel protection; dive/medical insurance; rental vehicle; airfare or other

transportation outside of initial transfer from and final transfer to Cozumel airport.
